<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Thursday 29th January</u> <i>Rehearsal 3</i></p> <p>1) Bruckner – Pange Lingua (p104) <i>(Detailed work on the piece, especially tuning the chords and finding flow with the text.)</i></p> <p>2) Stanford – Ye Choirs (p216) <i>(Detailed work on the opening (p216-219) and ending (p222-224) of the piece.)</i></p> <p>3) Vaughan Williams – 1. Easter (p3) <i>(Detailed work on movement.)</i></p> <p>4) Chilcott – Were you there (p126) <i>(Brief work on the piece.)</i></p>
